The assessment for most units of the BSc Computing and Information Systems is by unseen written paper and coursework. Students must satisfy the examiners in both elements of the assessment. The results given for a unit where coursework is required will be a combination of the mark for the written paper and the mark for the coursework. For examinations prior to 2007, the weighting for these elements is 85:15. From the examinations in 2007, the weighting is 80:20. The assessment for the Project is by a written report and unseen written paper, weighted at 70:30 respectively.

The unit 'Mathematics for business' is undertaken by Diploma in Computing and Information students only. Upon successful completion of the award, Diploma students may apply to proceed to the BSc degree.
